- 5 new SATA Packs with awkward problems:
- TR+00039 Intermittent bad playback.
- TR+00040 Intermittent bad playback.
- TR+00041 Bad playback. Conditioned once, bad statistics for disk 2/3. Swapped disk 2/3/with 6/7, conditioned again. Perfect.
- TR+00042 Bad playback. Re-inserted disks 2/3 into their sockets. Playback fine. TR+00045 Continuous bad playback. No action taken yet.



## **Disk Pack Problems**

## **CONDITIONING**:

When conditioning two packs at the same time, the pack in bank B will assume the VSN of the pack in bank A.

When conditioning a single pack, the VSN can become corrupt, often resulting in "Streamst" or a disk\_serial mismatch error.

After conditioning always rewrite the VSN!
